"I have learned to overcome fear and to express myself better."

Dilmer, 12, is in grade seven. School used to be a hard place for him to go, and he would worry about what others thought of him.

Now, thanks to you, he enjoys going to school and is enthusiastic and helpful in class. He is so confident that he's tutoring other children who have learning difficulties. He supports boys and girls, helping them grow in self-confidence and teaching them to read and write. Now Dilmer is on the school government and is a voice for those who had none.

Dilmer has recently become the leader of a group speaking out for other boys and girls who need help and support from their community. He organises activities for them, giving them an opportunity to learn and take part in games, making them feel included and valued. "I'm happy to meet people from different places, as well as with boys and girls from other schools," he says.

"I thank God, my family, teachers, friends and sponsor for making this possible. I'm proud to be part of this and will fight for the boys and girls," says Dilmer.






We've come a long way, and we're still making progress – *all thanks to you*.

We've been working with the community of Comunidades Solidarias since **2004**. Back then, children faced many problems: malnutrition; lack of sanitation; poor education; and feeling unsafe owing to high levels of violence.

Since then, things have begun to change for the better. Fewer children are malnourished, and immunisation against preventable diseases has led to less fear about falling ill; schools are more welcoming places for children, and families are learning to keep their children safe. Despite these improvements, life is still hard for children like your sponsored child.

Families are being hit hard by El Nino. With weather changing abruptly from drought to floods, they are finding it hard to grow crops and plan for their futures. But thanks to you, we're able to work alongside families, to help them cope. We really need your continuing support to ensure all the good we have managed to achieve isn't lost.

Thanks to your incredibly generous sponsorship of your sponsored child, we can stay in the area for another three to four years. We plan to leave in **2019**, but we will only go once we are confident that the change you have made, and the hope that you have given, will continue after we have left.



How you have helped this year...

- * A community group looks after the most vulnerable children.
- 199 families have safe drinking water near their homes.

- * 238 families joined savings groups and started their own businesses.
- Boys and girls have formed children's groups to learn about their rights.
- * Budding entrepreneurs are learning about new projects helping change their future.

"As I never married and haven't had children of my own it's been a blessing knowing that I have helped in some way to improve the lives of children a long way away and let them


know that I care about them and love them. I will always be a sponsor and support World Vision even when I'm gone."
